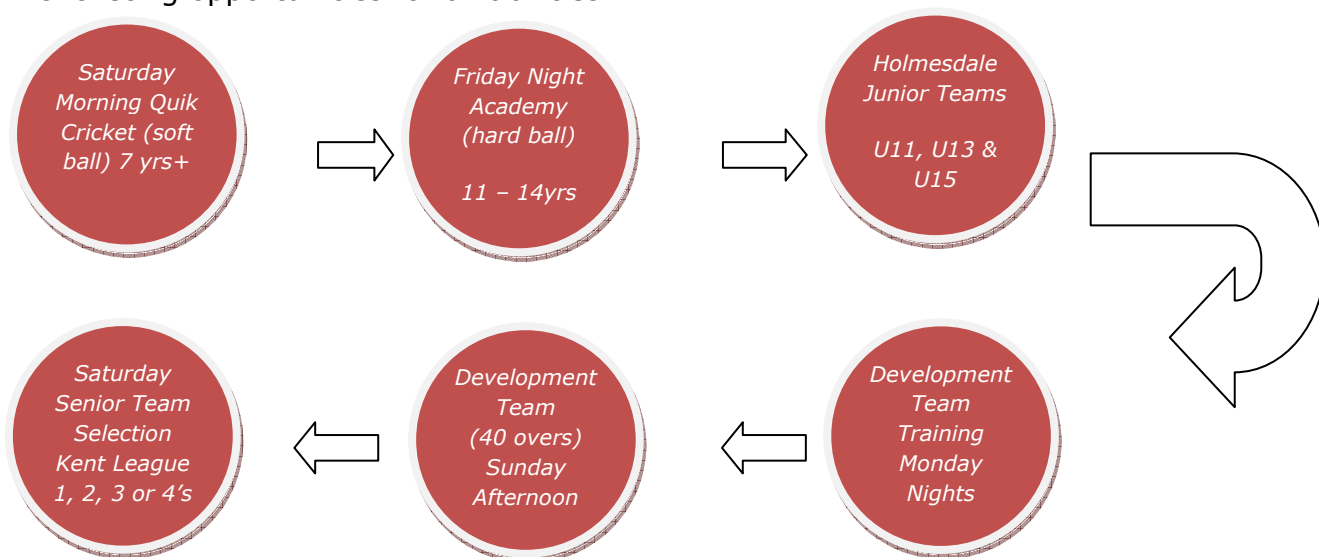




## HOLMESDALE CRICKET CLUB

### Junior Cricket Development Pathway

Holmesdale Cricket Club strongly believes in providing cricketing opportunities for all its members from junior to senior level. Below is the Clubs development pathway for young cricketers, showing the support structure, understanding and cricketing opportunities for all abilities.



The development structure brings cricketers through the junior section, and slowly introduces them to senior cricket. Every junior age group has a lead coach to nurture young talent, and feed them into the development team.

The development team training introduces advanced coaching skills and cricketing disciplines to challenge juniors as they move on from junior teams. This also encompasses the Clubs aim to retain and manage players from the age of 16 to 21 years, as they balance school exams, and University commitments. This structure allows players to flourish and progress into Saturday Kent League cricket when school cricket or University terms end.

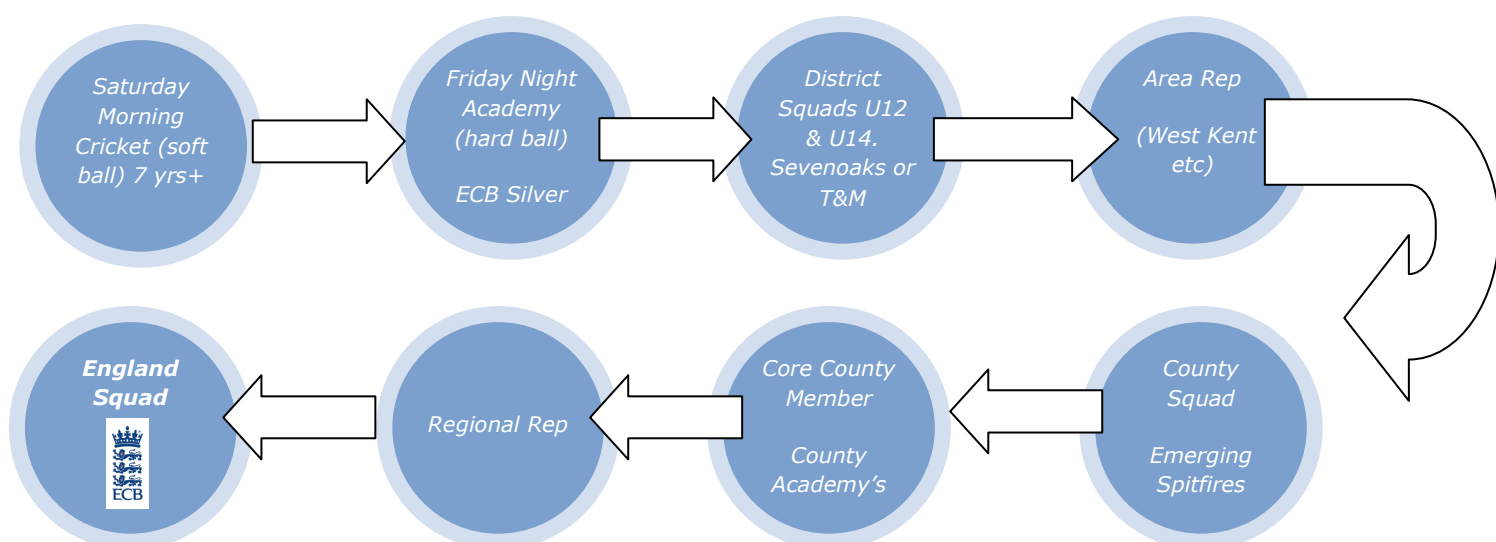
